PRODUCT DETAILS

These waxes are formulated on slower solvents than the toluene based waxes which they will eventually replace and give excellent build and shine on pine furniture.

They are formulated away from toluene solvent, which has received adverse publicity in recent years.

Similar colours are also available in the toluene based formulation see separate Data Sheet - 'Toluene Based Waxes'.

APPLICATION

- These waxes may be applied to bare timber or used over a base stain. Light Fast Stains, Rich Stains, Non Fade Ground Stains, Waterbased Stains.
- The following are suitable for use underneath this range of waxes: Light Fast Stains, Rich Stains, Non Fade Ground Stains, Waterbased Stains.
- The stain must be dry before application of the wax. See individual stain Data Sheets for drying times.
- Apply wax using a brush or a clean white lint-free cloth and buff off with another clean cloth.
- These waxes may also be sprayed by an experience wax sprayer using a high power airless (wax) spray pump. Please consult Mylands Technical Department before spraying for the first time.

COLOUR NOTES

Stripped Pine M7 the original colour and the Industry standard on pine.

Antique Brown second most popular pine colour, being slightly warmer than M7 a golden orange-brown tone.

Rustic Brown a darker version of Stripped Pine M7.

COVERAGE

Variable, will depend on porosity of timber used and coating thickness applied.

DRYING TIME




No more than 30 minutes at 20°C. Dependant on coating thickness applied and ambient temperature.
